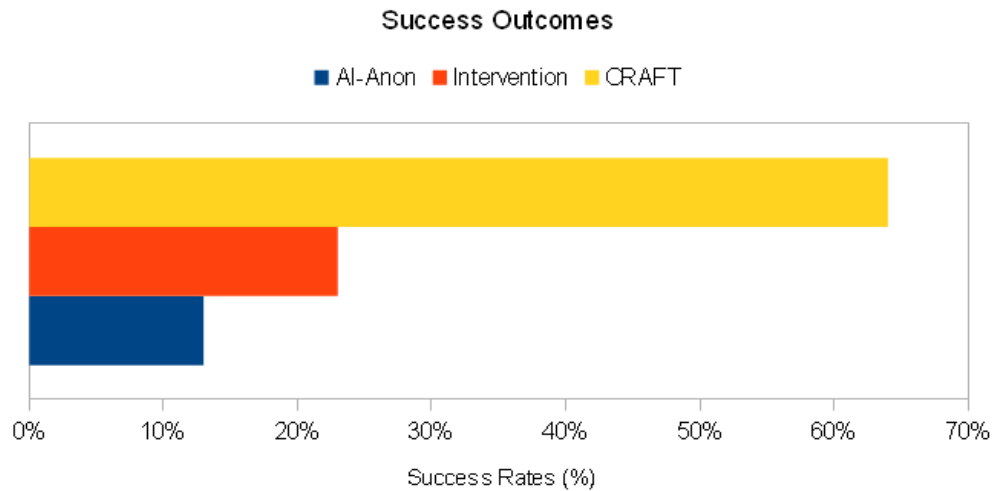


Beyond Addiction Family Support Group Trainings
